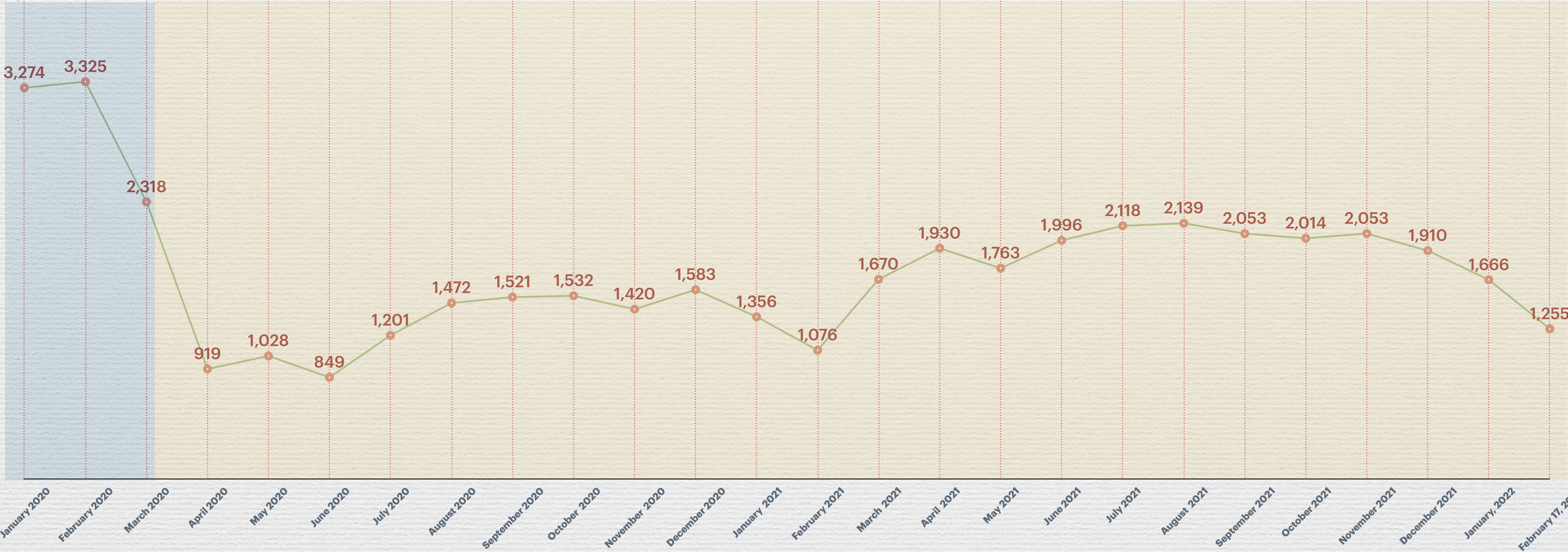

# Deviated—Fixed Route Ridership

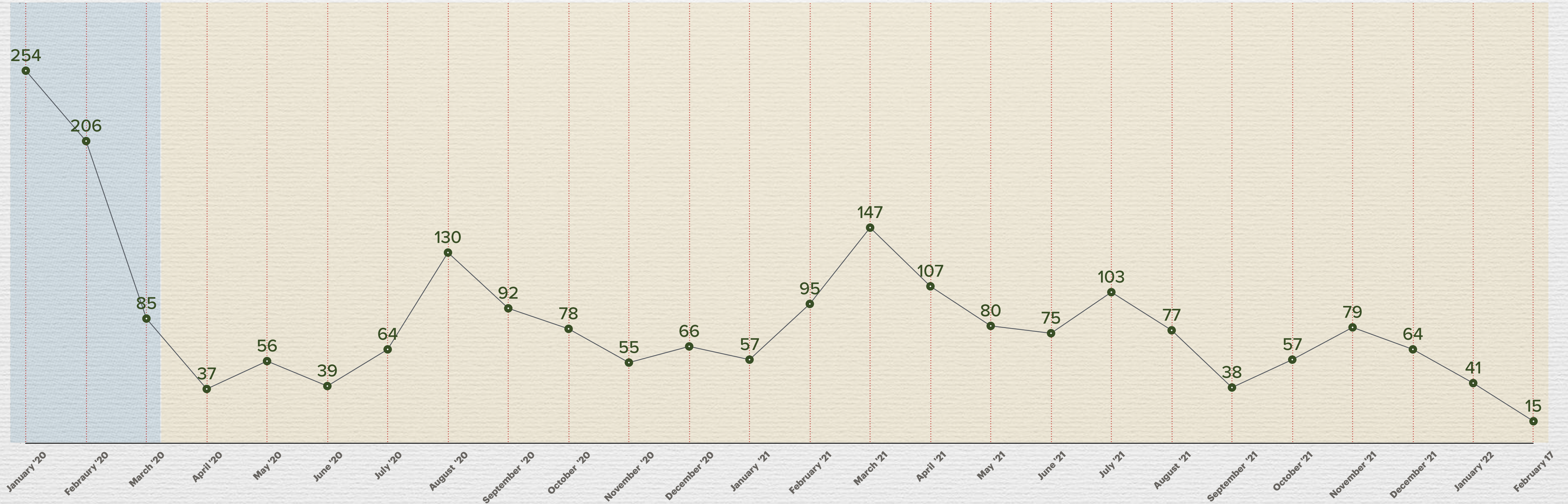

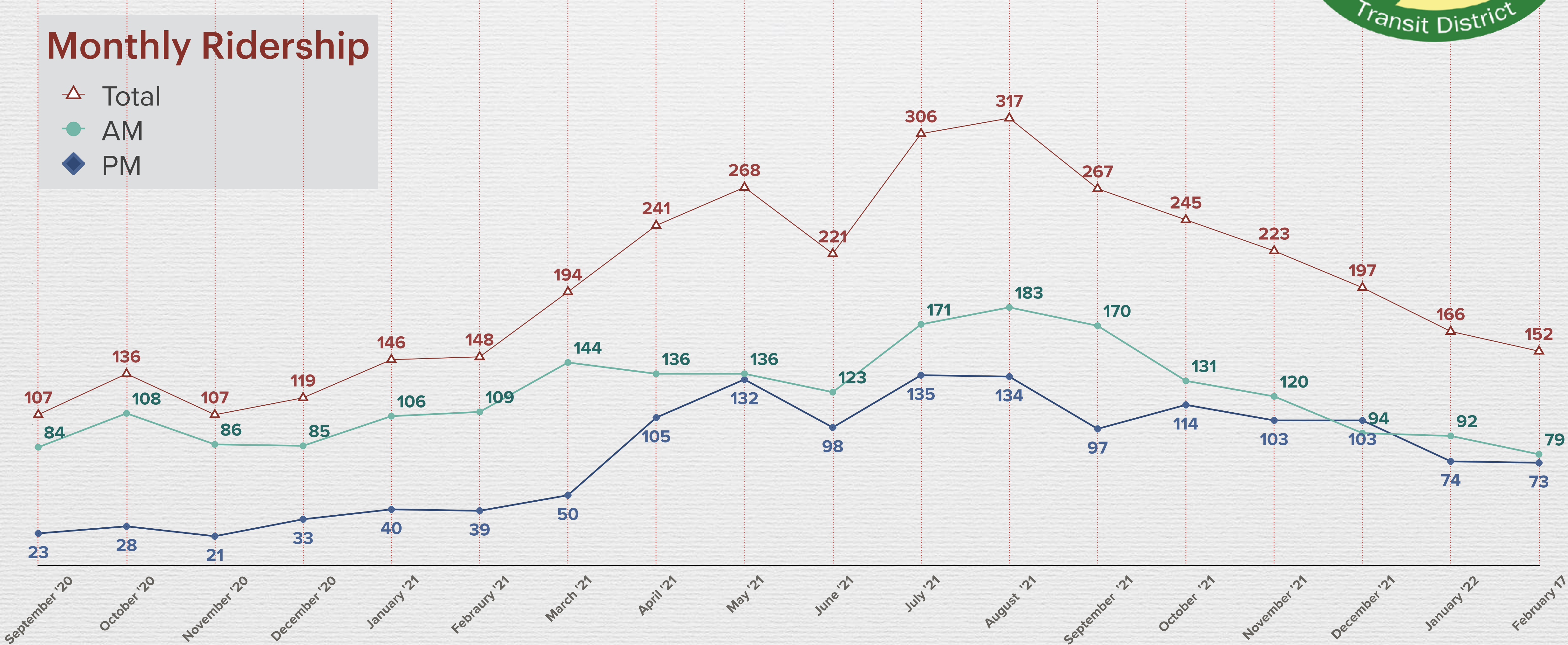
# Plainfield Pilot

## Monthly Ridership

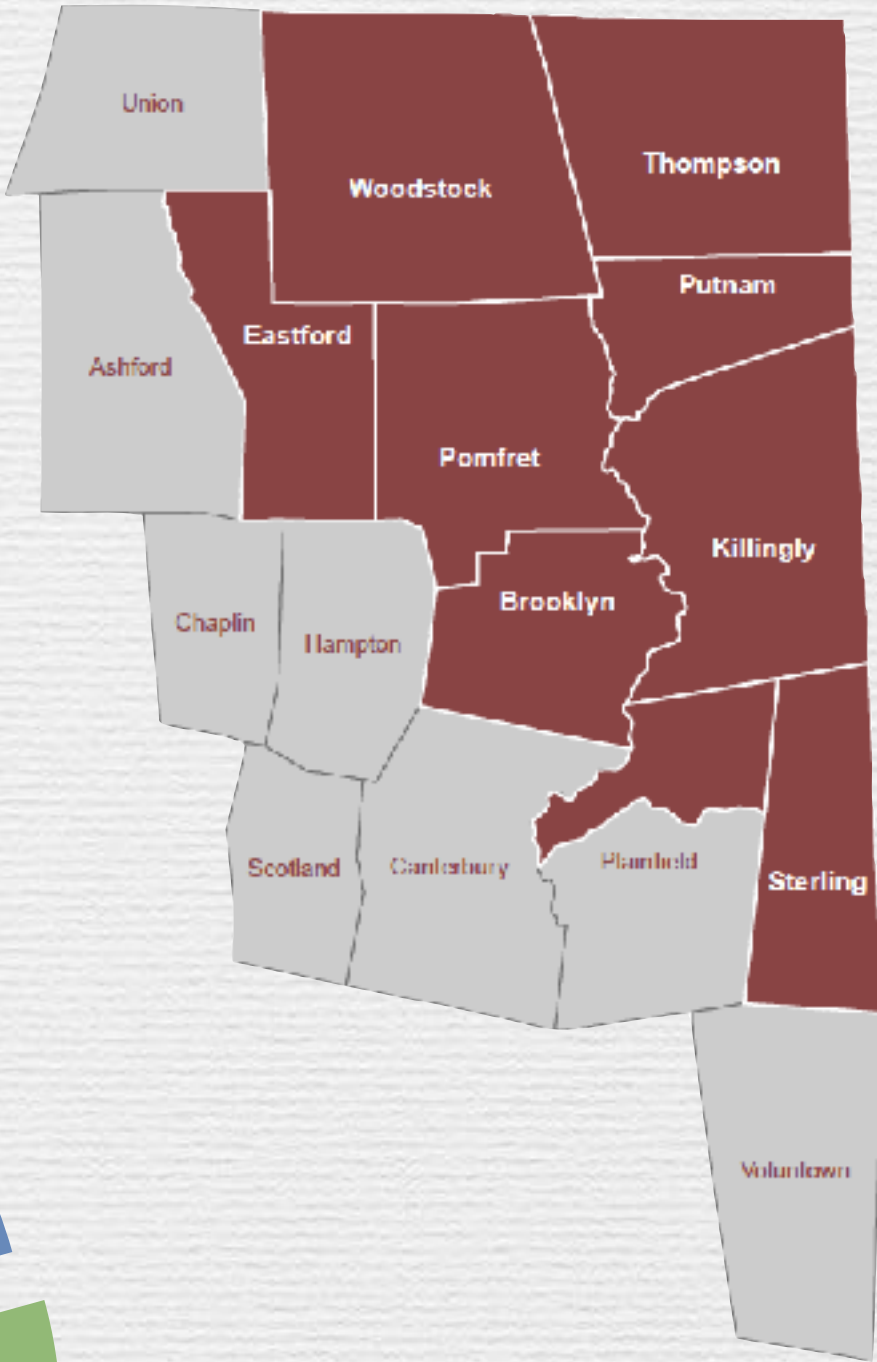
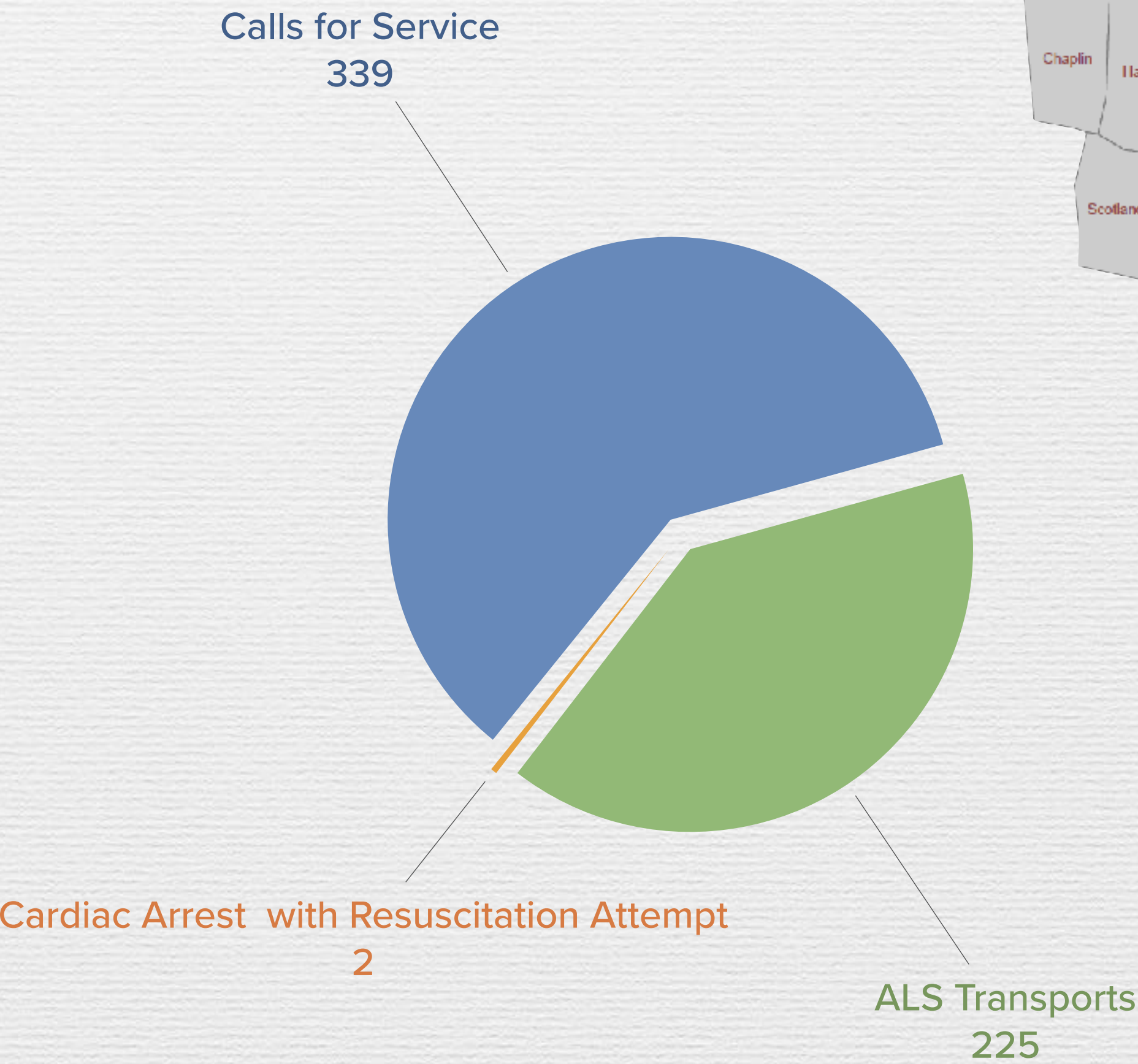
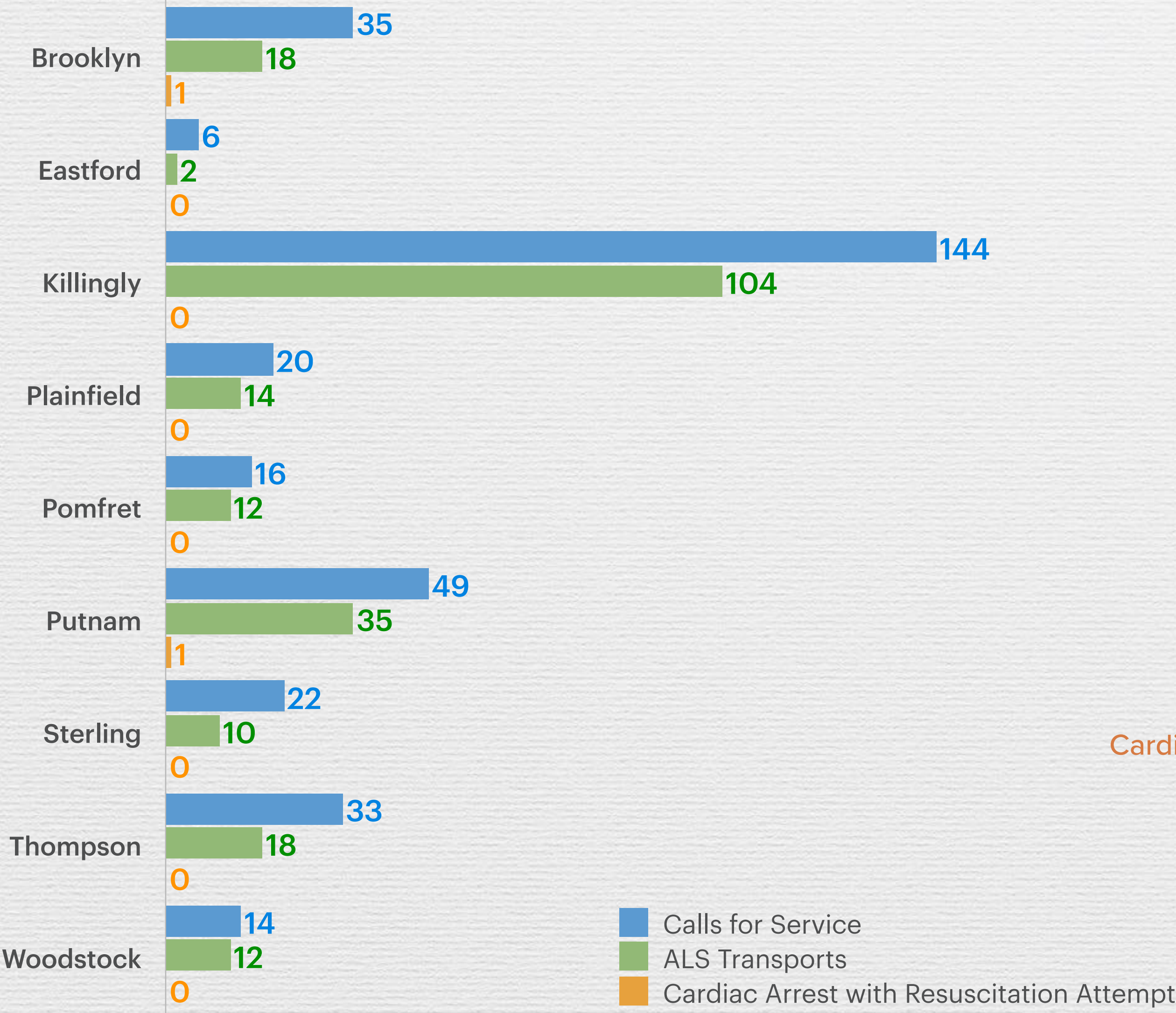

---



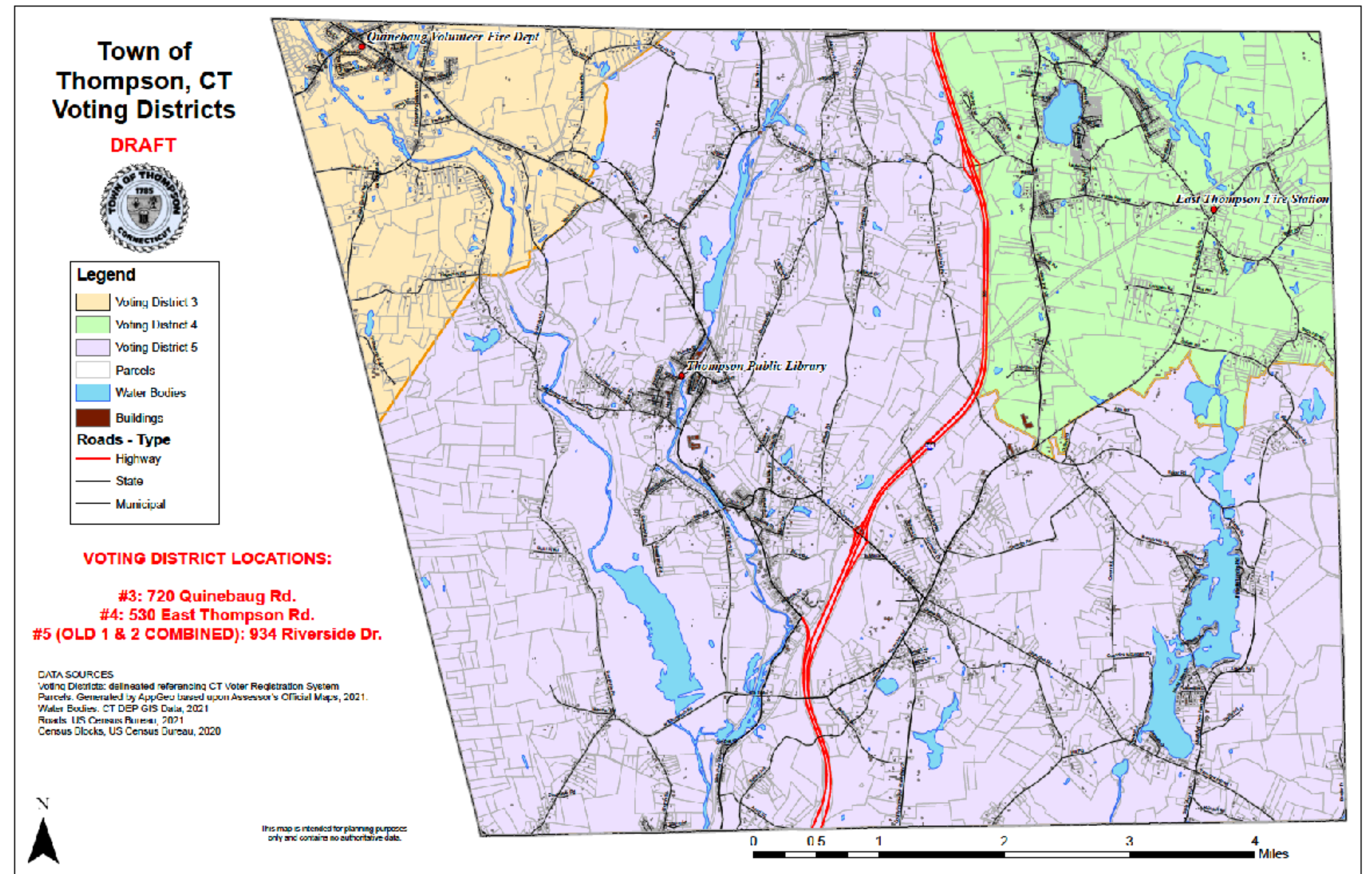
- **500** families (February 21) in **36 months** now back in their homes
